

APICALLY REPOSITIONED FLAP

In which cases are these surgeries necessary Apically Repositioned Flap, periodontal gum surgery ?

The aim of the periodontal therapy is to eliminate etiologic factors, correct sequels resulting from periodontal diseases and reestablish and maintain periodontal health. In these cases surgery is necessary in order to control and properly see the tissues.

Post-surgery care.

A pouch of ice should be placed on the surgical area in order to minimize the swollen for hours after the surgery.

Take the medication as prescribed.

Brushing, flossing and interdental brushing on the surgical area is suspended until the stitches are taken out.

Hygiene maintenance will be with chlorhexidine base mouth baths or with other mouth wash. After each meal apply a chlorhexidine gel one the stiches will be required.

The stitches will be taken out after 7- 10 days.
